Primary Care Centre - Brighouse, West Yorkshire

Successful national competition entry project for the centralisation and expansion of four independent medical facilities including: three GP surgeries, PCT clinics and potential 'shared' facilities to serve the patient population and reduce the necessity for hospital referral.

Prominent regeneration site on the banks of the River Calder adjacent to the town centre of Brighouse, calling for a landmark building. Main building accommodation over four floors with a further three storeys of basement car parking, the habitable space will total some 6300m².

The main building will house a Health Food Cafe and other associated retail plus conversion of existing building and expansion for Pharmacy.

The building benefits from large-scale atrium spaces to the main patient areas, with views across the river from the main waiting spaces.

The building design is of a high quality contemporary the surroundings and history of the town and provides a catalyst for the redevelopment of the river banks through Brighouse and more generally the town.
